### **Sensor technology contract award**

The Bristol-based Aero-Space division has been awarded a new sensor technology contract by the European Space Agency. Following on from SEA's successful Micro-Electrical Mechanical (MEMS) Rate Sensor development this will address use of MEMS accelerometers from Colibrys (Switzerland), as part of an Inertial Measurement Unit (IMU) demonstration targeting future lander, planetary rover and spacecraft applications. This 400k€ study covers requirements assessment, concept demonstration/analysis and development planning. System support for this study is provided by Thales Alenia Space (Cannes).
