



## **SEA helping Network Rail to improve performance tracking**

Network Rail has selected SEA to develop the replacement for their current Performance Action Tracking systems with a single application – iPAT. Network Rail has identified the need to replace, consolidate and enhance its existing, locally maintained, performance improvement activity capture systems with a single, centrally managed system that can record improvement activities from across Network Rail and its customers.

The iPAT system combines powerful bespoke data capture and custom benefit calculation with an industry standard Business Intelligence platform to support Network Rail's contribution to the Joint Performance Industry Plan, Public Performance Measure and inform performance targets as agreed with the Department for Transport, Office of Rail Regulation and industry customers.

SEA will combine bespoke software development and systems integration experience to deliver an iPAT system that satisfies Network Rail's requirements and provides an effective tool that will maximise Network Rail's capability to analyse project metrics and achieved predicted benefits across improvement projects on the UK rail network.
